

1. WTM (RE-ACCREDITATION): PRE-REQUISITES



- Basic literacy and numeracy skills.** Please contact us if you wish to discuss this further.
- Unique Student Identifier** number (USI Number)
- Photo ID**
- Copy or photo of **Construction White Card / Safety Awareness Card**
- Copy or photo of current / previous valid **Australian Driver's Licence** - minimum probationary.
- Been actively engaged in the traffic management industry in the last 12 months
- BWTM Main Roads WA **Certificate of Accreditation** (N/A if previous student of Perth Traffic Training)
- WTM Main Roads WA **Certificate of Accreditation** (N/A if previous student of Perth Traffic Training)

Statements of Attainment (minimum) for BWTM: (N/A if previous student of Perth Traffic Training)

- RIIWHS201E Work safely and follow WHS policies and work procedures.
- RIICOM201E Communicate in the workplace.
- RIIWHS302E Implement a traffic management plan accreditation

Statements of Attainment (minimum) for WTM: (N/A if previous student of Perth Traffic Training)

- RIIRIS402E – Carry out risk management process (or equivalent)

- Traffic management plan with multiple TGS and speed reductions that was implemented that you amended. The submission should include risk assessment and daily diary; and
- A copy of an onsite inspection of a roadwork or event traffic management site you have completed.

OR

Where your primary role is reviewing, recommending and/or authorising Traffic Management Plans, provide:

- Traffic Management Plan you have reviewed or approved with your review comments, for assessment.

2. HELP

Literacy and Numeracy:

Students must have basic literacy and numeracy skills in the English language to complete assessments, understand traffic guidance schemes and documentation and communicate effectively in a traffic management environment. Please contact us if you wish to discuss this further.

Proof of Identity (POI):

Applicants can prove their identity with any **ONE** of the following current full POI documents:

- Photographic driver's licence issued within Australia or from a country approved by the department of Transport
- Australian passport
- Document of identity issued by the Passport Office
- Photographic identity card issued by Main Roads, Australian Defence Force, Australian Federal, State or Territory Police Service

WA photographic (security) licence issued by or cleared with the WA Police Service

Drivers Licence:

Copy or photo of current / previous valid **Australian Driver's Licence**.

A **USI** is your individual education number for life. It also gives you an online record of your VET training undertaken in Australia.

You must have evidence from the www.usi.gov.au website of your USI number, emailed to info@perthtrafficttraining.com.au for validation, prior to course.

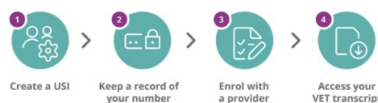

If you're at university, TAFE or doing other nationally recognized training, you need a USI. Without one, you can't get Commonwealth financial assistance or your qualification or statement of attainment.

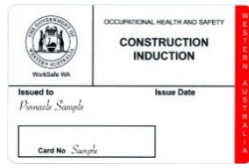
